



Dreamy Shawl

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Pattern Introduction

The simple construction of this knitted shawl allows you to explore color choices with abandon! Wear it front and center as shown, or off to the side. A crocheted shell edge and handmade buttons finishes it off. A great project for using stash leftovers OR an excuse to purchase one skein of this and one of that☺. Thread ribbons through the stitches to add decoration and variety to the shawl.



What you need

4-12 different yarns in Worsted Weight range totaling approximately 400 yds
(**Note:** Lighter weight yarns can be doubled to become “worsted” weight. Please see the **Tips for Combining Colors** section on pages 4-5 of this pattern!)

Size 11, round or straight needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Size G or H crochet hook (depending on weight of yarn used for edging)

A couple of ¼ - ½” ribbons, 2 ft. long (opt.)

Yarn Needle

Stitches you need to know

Stockinette Stitch: Knit a row, Purl a row

Garter Stitch: Knit every row
Pick up and knit stitches along row ends

For crochet edging:

Single Crochet
Double Crochet
