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## Pattern Introduction

A simple fold creates this knitted shrug, perfect for a little extra warmth on fall and spring days or at the movie theater. You'll enjoy the ease of stockinette and garter rows, then lacing it up with a beautiful ribbon. I used Patagonia's sumptuous Araucania Cotton, but you can choose any aran weight yarn. Pair with jeans or a dress...but be prepared for folks to stop you and want to take a closer look. 😊



## What you need

525 yards of Aran weight yarn (I used  
5 hanks of Patagonia's Araucania  
cotton, 105 yds. each)  
Size 10 knitting needles  
4 yards coordinating ribbon  
Split Marker  
Yarn Needle

## Stitches you need to know

**Garter Stitch:** Knit every row  
**Stockinette Stitch:** Knit a row, Purl a  
row

## Techniques you need to know

Nothin' fancy...just straight knitting  
and a wee bit of seaming.
