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Pattern Introduction

A very simple, crocheted, open weave scarf using the classic V stitch. It has a shell edging on both ends to finish it off. Use beautiful, shimmery yarns, or something sumptuously simple. You decide how long you want it to be for the oh-so-many ways you can wear a scarf. Make one for all your friends!



What you need

400 yds. DK Weight Yarn (I used 2 balls of St. Charles *Ritrato*) Less yardage if you choose to make a smaller scarf...mine is 2 yards long☺

Size J or K hook (try a simple swatch of either to see which one gives you the look you want: drapey, loose stitches that still hold their shape)
